U8 (born 2017 and up – minimum white belt)

U10 (born 2015-2016 – white & up)

U12 (born 2013-2014 – white & up)

U14 (born 2011-2012 – white & up) male & female separate.

U16 (born 2009-2010 – white belt & up) male & female separate.

Senior Men Novice (born 2009 & older-white to orange belt)

Senior Men Advanced (born 2009 & older-green belt and up)

Senior Women Novice (born 2009 & older-white to orange belt)

Senior Women Advanced (born 2009 & older-green belt and up)

*Draws will be made for the divisions based on entries. A round robin pool system will be used where each entrant will compete against the other pool members.*

### **Ne Waza Rules**

U8	1.5 minutes, straight time	These will be exhibition matches to allow coaches and competitors to be on the mat at the same time to learn the ne-waza tournament system.	All receive medal
U10	2 minutes, straight time	no scoring	All receive medal
U12	2 minutes	Judo Canada Ne waza scoring to be used	Based on placing
U14	3 minutes	Judo Canada Ne waza scoring to be used	Based on placing
U16	3 minutes	Judo Canada Ne waza scoring to be used, Golden Score	Based on placing
Senior	4 minutes	Judo Canada Ne waza scoring to be used, Golden Score	Based on placing

### **Tachi Waza Rules**

U8	None allowed		
U10	2 minutes, straight time	Ends with 2 Ippon	All receive medal
U12	2 minutes	Ends with 1 Ippon, No golden score	Based on placing
U14	3 minutes	Ends with 1 Ippon, No golden score	Based on placing
U16	3 minutes	Ends with 1 Ippon, Golden Score	Based on placing
U18	4 minutes	Ends with 1 Ippon, Golden Score	Based on placing
Senior	4 minutes	Ends with 1 Ippon, Golden Score	Based on placing

**\*\*No trophies if only one person in division**

**Tournament Guidelines:**

- Modified Judo Canada Tournament Sanctioning Rules will apply.
- White belts and white/yellow split belts may participate in Ne-waza only.
- There will be no shime waza or kansetsu waza in any match where either competitor is less than a green belt.
- All competitors must have a white judogi. All judogis must be regulatory size.
- No use of bleeding dyes on the body or hair of competitors is allowed. In cases such use is undetected and results in damage to the equipment of the opponent or the tatami, the competitor will be disqualified, and the member will be charged for the damage.
- Females must wear a plain white short-sleeved rounded-neck shirt under their judogi.
- Hair must be worn up above the shoulders (male & female), hair bands can not contain any metal.
- All piercings and jewelry must be removed.
